Within the Formation Collaborative, the Office of Employee Leadership Development aims to pursue whole-person formation for faculty and staff through leadership development. Our goal is to train and support all members of the Belmont community do their jobs well and grow into the leader God created them to be. At Belmont, everyone is seen as a leader, regardless of title or experience.

Undergirded by the SOUL framework, we focus on how to lead with character in three domains: self, others, and impact. The hope is that everyone can find themselves in our programming, whether it's one-on-one coaching, position/experienced based academies, or open-call seminar style learning opportunities.

• Emerging Leader Development Program Staff | Semesterly | Launching Fall 2025

The ELDP is a four-month, nomination based program, consisting of monthly in-person workshops, self-directed learning via LinkedIn Learning, and between-session accountability and coaching. This targeted leadership development program aims to provide staff with the opportunity to network and build connections, and equip them with fundamental leadership skills needed to lead effectively in leadership roles at Belmont.

• Academic Leadership Network (ALN) Faculty | Launching Fall 2025

The ALN is an umbrella offering designed to support faculty in administrative leadership roles including chairs, directors, assistant & associate deans, and deans. It includes ongoing resources via help online guides, as well as position-specific cohort programs.

• Chairs & Directors Academy Faculty | Annual | Launching Fall 2025

The Chairs and Directors Academy within the Academic Leadership Network is a recommendation based cohort program designed to equip new and experienced department chairs, program directors, and smiller positions with the tools they need to transition into their roles and be successful in managing their work.

• Leadership Champions Network (LCN) Faculty & Staff | Ongoing | Launching Fall 2025

The LCN is a representative group of faculty and staff leaders from across campus who are committed to promoting character education. The LCN is designed to empower and support these champions in their character education efforts.
